The evidence strongly suggests that internal communication is positively related to RD project performance (Allen, 1964; 1977;Baker et al, 1967; Goldhar, et al, 1976), all supporting the proposition that the best source of information for an RD engineer is a colleague within his own organization. Good internal communication, therefore, assumes a paramount importance for the management of an RD organization. Other studies (Allen, et al, 1977; Dewhirst, et al, 1978; Hagstrom, 1965)have shown the relation between project performance and communication outside of the laboratory to be a function of whether the project involves research, development or technical service activities. In fact, the relation shifts from a positive to a negative one, depending on the nature of the project. While a strong, positive relationship between performance and external communication was found for research scientists and engineers, the relationship between performance and direct external contacts was...
