The test of metre, as Mr Skeat points out, gives the same result, as it shows that it was one of his early works. It is most probable that the main part of the poem was written soon after 1373, and that it was afterwards fitted, with some changes and additions, into the series of the Canterbury Tales. The Prologue must, of course, have been written subsequently to Petrarchs...
